THE Curragh, famed horse-breeding centre in Co. Kildare, established a new claim to fame when Lakeland terrier, Tully-Token, bred there by Mr. Arthur McAteer, was named best terrier at the All-American Championship Show at Madison Square Garden, New York.

Tully Token, which Mr. McAteer, an international dog show judge and exhibitor, had sold to American fancier, Anton Rost, beat 2,500 other Lakelands to the title.

Before that the dog, which answers to the pet name "Rin", won Green Star and best of breed awards in Dublin Cork and Athy.
